

ORDINANCE RESTRICTING DUMPING OF SEPTIC TANK REFUSE ON LAND

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board, Town of Louisville, St. Lawrence County, New York, at the Town Hall in said town on the 17th. day of June 1964 at 7:30 P.M. for the purpose of the adoption of the following ordinance:

RESOLVED, that no refuse from Septic Tanks be allowed to be discharged on any land within the limits of the Town of Louisville unless specific approval is obtained from the Town Board and any violation of same be subject to arrest and a fine of twenty-five (\$25) dollars for the first offense and fifty (\$50) dollars for the second and subsequent offenses.

This ordinance shall be in effect upon adoption and publication as provided by law.
